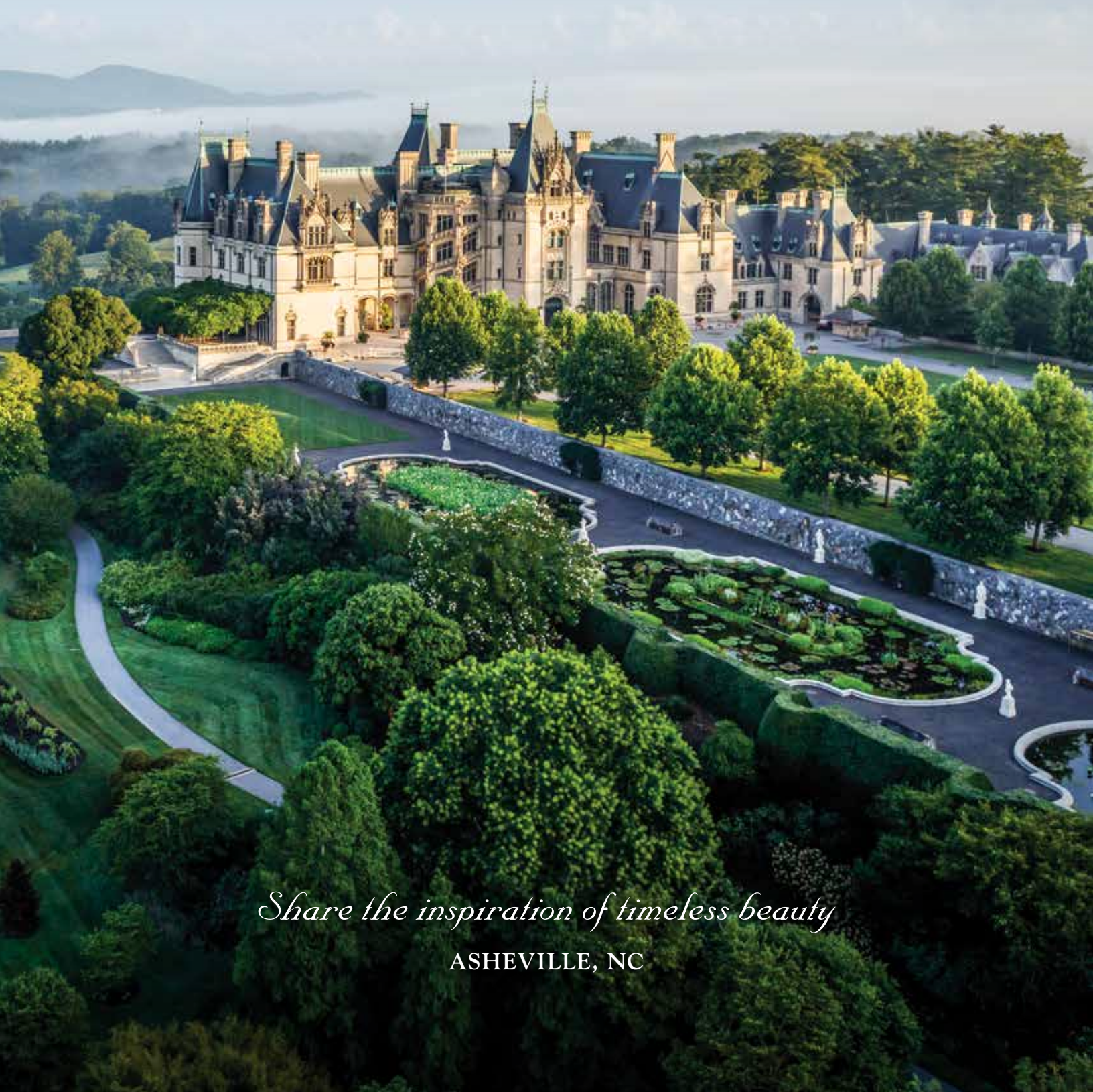

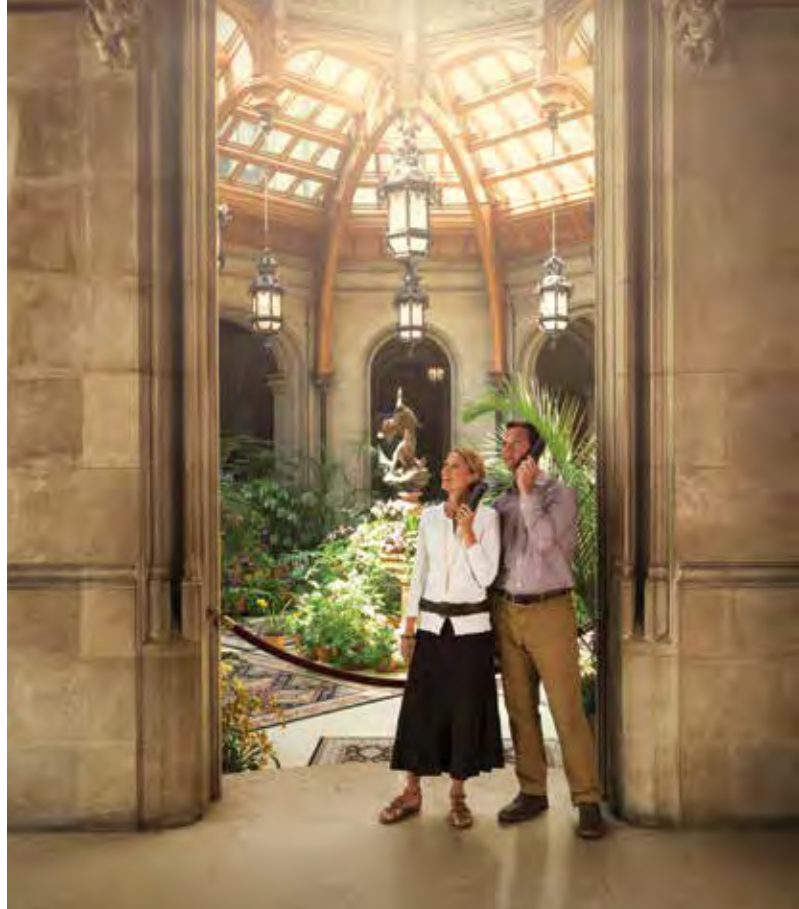

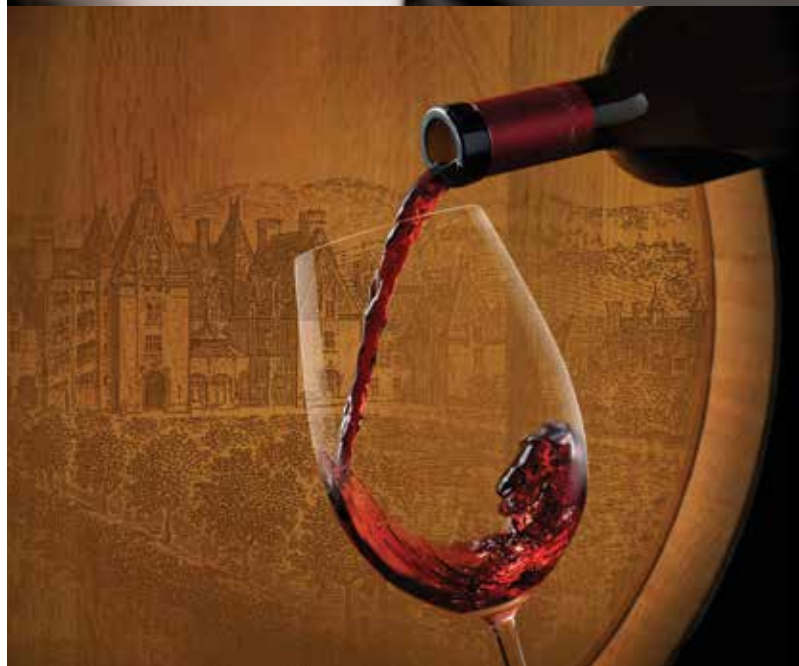

In following the Vanderbilts' leadership in environmental stewardship and conservation of our natural resources, Biltmore is proud to promote the following options for your events:

- ◇ Our Field to Table Program offers estate-raised meats and seasonal vegetables and herbs from our Production Garden to be used in estate restaurants.
- ◇ In addition to estate provisions, we source many of our ingredients from sustainable farmers and artisans in the area.
- ◇ We are happy to prepare organic menus. Our coffee is organic and fair-trade.
- ◇ Bulk containers for snacks and water in order to reduce the amount of disposables are available.
- ◇ We offer sustainable meeting room options such as pencils from recycled sources, recycled tablet paper, and dry erase boards.
- ◇ Donation of event florals to local retirement homes as well as the donation of food when appropriate can be arranged.

- ◇ Our corporate philanthropy program proudly supports Habitat for Humanity, MANNA FoodBank, and Mountain Housing Opportunities.

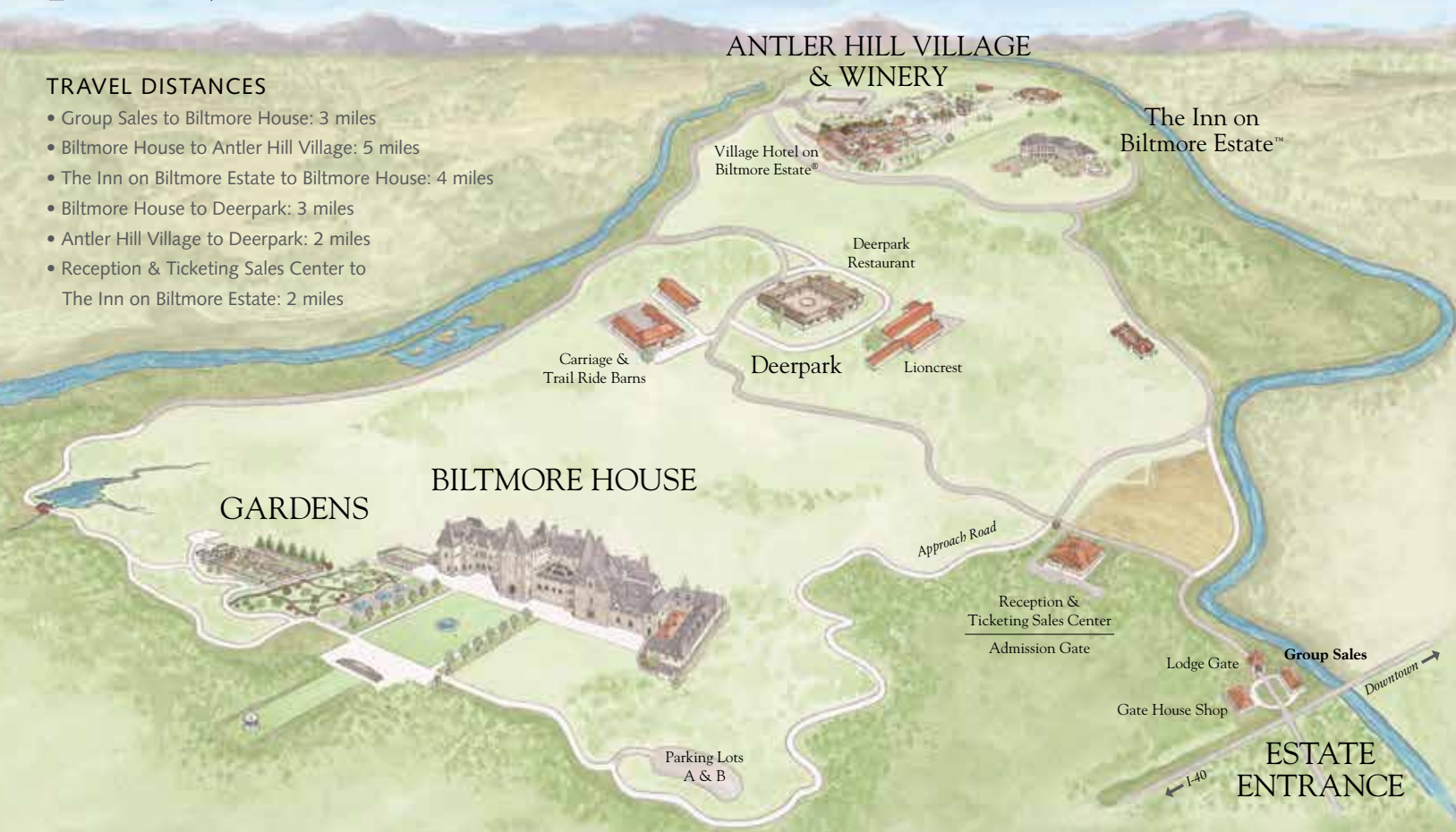


ESTATE MAP

- ◇ When Biltmore House was built more than 100 years ago, daily wages were \$4 for stonecutters, \$2.25–\$2.75 for cabinetmakers, and \$2.25 for carpenters.
- ◇ Nearly 5,000 tons of Indiana limestone was used to construct Biltmore House.
- ◇ The 72-foot-long Banquet Hall carries sound so well that guests sitting at each end of the 40-foot table can converse without raising their voices.
- ◇ Oak leaves and acorns—symbols of strength used in the Vanderbilt family crest—can be seen throughout Biltmore House.
- ◇ The National Gallery stored works of art in Biltmore House during World War II to keep them safe in case Washington, D.C. was bombed.
